## Driving Route

| When to Cue                                     | Verbal Cue   | Driving Maneuver  | Notes |
|---|--|---|-------|
| <i>From parking spot.</i>                       | <b>Drive to the Grove Street Exit of the parking lot &amp; turn right.</b> | Problem solving exit, unprotected right turn.   |       |
| <i>Immediately after right turn onto Grove</i>  | <b>Follow Grove Street</b>   | 25 mph, gentle curves, neighborhood, positioning on wide lanes.                       |       |
| <i>At the top of the hill.</i>                  | <b>At the bottom of the hill turn left.</b>                                | Stop sign only for us, unprotected left turn.   |       |
| <i>When 4-way intersection comes into view.</i> | <b>Continue straight on this road.</b>                                     | Busy 4 way stop sign  |       |
| <i>After passing thru 4-way stop sign</i>       | <b>Continue to follow this road</b>  | Sharp left curve in road, narrow roads, speed hump                                    |       |
| <i>After sharp left bend in the road</i>        | <b>Make your first left onto Kimmel's Road.</b>                            | Unprotected left with left turn lane; scan for street; poor lane markings.            |       |
| <b>NO CUE</b>                                   | <b>Follow Kimmel's Road.</b>   | School zone & speed change  |       |
| <i>After passing school</i>                     | <b>In two intersections, make a left onto Market Street.</b>               | Management of blinking yellow traffic light (we have right of way), unprotected left. |       |
